## ABOUT THE MUSEUM

The Framework Knitters Museum in Ruddington is a unique example of a 19th century knitters' yard. The cottages and frameshops are grouped together around a courtyard garden together with a laundry, pigsty and privies. The back-to-back cottage makes evident the harsh life of a poor framework knitters' family and contrasts with the larger end cottage which was the home of the hosier who owned the site.

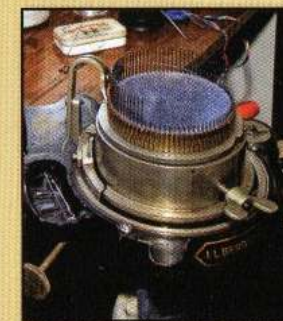


This working museum offers demonstrations on the authentic stocking frames, and visitors can "have-a-go" on the circular knitting machines.

Just across the street, the former Primitive Methodist Chapel has been converted into an exhibition and meeting area with excellent facilities.

On display is a unique collection of socks and stockings covering two centuries, including a pair of stockings worn by Queen Victoria. The Chapel also houses an extensive research library.
